| Sat. Jan. 5 @ 10am | Punderson: Iroquois and Boardwalk Trail, Moderate. Meet at the Lodge. |
| Sat. Jan. 12 @ 10am | Pymatuning: Old Forest Wilderness, Moderate. Meet at Poplar Grove Picnic Area. |
| Sun. Jan. 13 @ 10am | West Branch: Campground Trail, Moderate. Meet at the Campground check station. |
| Sat. Jan. 26 @ 10am | Jefferson Lake: Lakeside Loop Trail, Intermediate. Meet at the parking lot below the dam. |
| Sun. Jan. 27 @ 10am | Wingfoot: Wildlife Trail, Easy short hike. Meet at the Marina Parking Lot. |
| Sat. Feb. 2 @ 10am | Findley: Wyandot & Hickory Trail, Moderate. Meet at the Campground Picnic Shelter. |
| Sat. Feb. 9 @ 10am | Beaver Creek: Dogwood Trail, Intermediate. Meet at the Large Parking Lot near the bridge. |
| Sat. Feb. 16 @ 2pm | Portage Lakes: Shoreline Trail, Moderate. Meet at the Big Oaks Parking Lot. |
| Sat. Feb. 16 @ 7pm | Mohican Lodge: Gazebo Trail, Easy to Moderate. Meet at the Lodge Lobby. |
| Sat. Feb. 23 @ 10am | Geneva: Orange and Blue Trail, Moderate. Meet at the Beach Parking Lot. |
| Sat. Feb. 23 @ 2pm | Headlands Beach: Hiking into the Mentor Marsh Boardwalk, Moderate. Meet at the west end of the Beach Parking Lot. |
